



# Return to Play – Checklist

Host Club

## Checklist for Host Club

*This checklist has been developed to support Host Clubs with 'Returning to Play':*

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### PRE-MATCH

1. Be aware of any COVID-19 LWA Return to Play Guidelines. Ensure that your committee and members know of these guidelines prior to hosting games.
  2. When setting up grounds, marquees, tables, chairs, goals etc. must all be sanitised.
  3. Do NOT assist with setting/packing up if you have any flu like symptoms - fever, runny nose, cough.
  4. The following items and pieces of equipment must be sanitised prior to and after each game. There is a 10 minute window between the conclusion of one game to the next team entering the bench area: – Lacrosse goals, lacrosse balls, playing bench chairs, technical bench chairs, scorer's table, timers, scoreboard, time display flipchart (women's) and pens.
  5. Hand sanitiser, antiseptic wipes and disposable gloves must be made available on the technical bench for teams, officials and Host Club volunteers.
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### POST-MATCH

1. The following items and pieces of equipment must be sanitised prior to and after each game. There is a 10 minute window between the conclusion of one game to the next team entering the bench area: – Lacrosse goals, lacrosse balls, playing bench chairs, technical bench chairs, scorer's table, timers, scoreboard, time display flipchart (women's) and pens.
  2. Lost equipment, clothing and other personal items should be stored in an area where it does not come into contact or can be touch by members and must be handled with disposable gloves. 'No contact' claim; Host club to assist retrieval of lost items by owner.
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### CANTEEN AND BARS

1. Complete your COVID Safety Plan and display certificate in your canteen.
2. Canteen and Bar Managers to complete the Covid-19 Infection Control Training. It is recommended that they also complete the Covid-19 Hygiene Officer Course. Certificates to be displayed in the canteen/bar.

3. Do NOT assist in the canteen or bar if you have any flu like symptoms - fever, runny nose, cough.
  4. Canteen and bar area to indicate, using signage, the maximum number of people that can be in each space to assist with compliance.
  5. Conduct frequent environmental cleaning and disinfection especially of touch-points (door handles, EFTPOS facilities, counters, table tops, backs of chairs, food preparation areas etc.
  6. Consider Cashless and non-contact payments, menu options that require minimal handling/contact, use disposable gloves appropriately.
  7. Manage shared spaces – signage and barriers to direct traffic, consider a dedicated entrance and exit, reduce seating to encourage social distancing.
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#### **CLUBROOM, CHANGEROOMS AND TOILETS**

1. Complete your COVID Safety Plan and display certificate in your clubrooms.
  2. Display signage at the clubroom entrance, toilets and changerooms to instruct members not to enter if they are unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms.
  3. Changerooms limited to Players and Officials. Players/Officials have been instructed to arrive at the game dressed ready to play/officiate.
  4. Hand sanitiser must be available and members encouraged to use on entry and exit.
  5. Clubrooms, changerooms and toilets to indicate, using signage, the maximum number of people that can be in each space to assist with compliance.
  6. Conduct frequent environmental cleaning and disinfection of toilets and display checklist of cleaning times.
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
